Hope Hospice Joins the New Balance Falmouth Road Race *Sign-up Deadline is August 9, 2015*

Hyannis, MA – [Hope Hospice](#), part of the HopeHealth family of services, is excited to participate in the New Balance Falmouth Road Race on Sunday, August 16, 2015. Five runners can join the Hope Hospice race team and claim one of our guaranteed Numbers for Nonprofits. The Numbers for Nonprofits Program provides Massachusetts based, 501(c)(3) nonprofits with the opportunity to purchase race entries to use for fundraising purposes. The program enables community organizations to guarantee a number and bib for those who raise funds while running in the race.

The New Balance Falmouth Road Race celebrates its 43rd running this year and the spirit which made the first Falmouth so special is still present today. More than 12,000 runners will gather in Woods Hole for the 2015 renewal, including many of the world's elite, though the essence of the event will always remain a fun run. Back-of-the-pack joggers share the road with the best, forming a tapestry of colors from the start on Water Street to the finish at the beach in Falmouth Heights.

The New Balance Falmouth Road Race asks each participant to raise a minimum of \$750. Runners for Hope Hospice help to ensure that anyone who is eligible receives the services, care and support needed for the best possible quality of life.

Upon return of the Runner Registration/Waiver Form, a link and code to register for the New Balance Falmouth Road Race will be emailed to participants. The sign-up deadline to have a participant's name on the bib is July 1, with a final deadline to sign up by August 9, 2015.

“This is our fifth year participating in the New Balance Falmouth Road Race,” said David Rehm, president and CEO of HopeHealth. “It’s an event that brings people together to raise essential funds to support patients and families who need our care, in one of road racing’s most beautiful venues.”
